

How to arrive:

Airports

Zaventem: (10km) closest airport to Brussels. Take the bus 12 to the city, or train to Central/Midi/Schuman/Luxembourg. You can then take other public transport to the office/hotel. Schuman and Luxembourg are within walking distance.

Charleroi: (60km) to reach Brussels, you will need to take the <u>flibco</u> bus to Gare du Midi (ϵ 16.60 each way), you will then need to take other public transport to the office/hotel. Alternatively, there is a door-to-door option (+/- ϵ 45 each way)

Train

The main train station in Brussels is Gare du Midi (Eurostar), with connections to metro and bus. Other stations include Gare Central, Gare Schuman, Gare Luxembourg which are all connected with metro and bus.
